SERMON STUDY

Read these verses before you begin your discussion: Luke 14:7-24

Dive deeper into this week's message and passage from the Bible. Here are some questions to help you guide your group discussion.

The invitation was really urgent: in this parable, Jesus is looking for people who needed to be filled up to come to the table. Have you responded to Jesus' invitation to follow him? Are you inviting others to the table right now?

Change is hard, but it keeps us on mission. How do you respond to change? Do you resist it or welcome it? In what ways do you sense God might be asking you to change for the sake of his mission?

Jesus wants you to be **all in**. Do you show up to group, to serve, and to worship expecting to meet with God? If not, why not?

what you're comfortable with?

Day five: Luke 14:7-24 | Reflect: what do you notice that you didn't notice earlier? What is God teaching you through this passage? How will you respond?
