- Missional Partner/Organization Christian Missionary Fellowship (CMF) and Missions of Hope International (MOHI): We partner with CMF and MOHI to come alongside individuals and families living in the Mathare Valley, a slum located outside Nairobi, Kenya. Through this partnership, you will have the opportunity to join God in a work of restoration and redemption in the lives of those living in society's shadows. MOHI wants to see individuals come out of these shadows and discover their God-given talents. MOHI accomplishes this through a variety of ministries that focus on empowerment through education, health care, and skills training.
- **Passport & Visa Information** Each person needs a US passport, and it must be valid at least SIX MONTHS beyond stay in country.
- Immunizations Make sure you are up to date on routine vaccines (MMR, Tetanus, etc.) and Polio (with a one-time booster as an adult if you have not had one). Hepatitis A and Typhoid are recommended, and Malaria medication is recommended if going on the Safari.
- Weather There are on average around 6 days of rain during June, and the average high temperatures are in the low to mid 80's and the average low temperatures are in the low to mid 60's.
- Accommodations While in Nairobi the team will be staying in a guesthouse.
- **Ground Transportation** The team will fly into Nairobi, Kenya and will be transported by bus to the various areas they will be serving while in country.
- Medical attention In the event of a serious illness or medical emergency, there are medical clinics and hospitals nearby. Included in your trip cost is travel medical insurance that will cover expenses if medical attention is needed while outside of the US.
