- Missional Partner/Organization Back2Back Ministries: We partner with Back2Back Ministries which is an international Christian non-profit organization that is dedicated to being a voice for orphans. They exist to love and care for orphans and vulnerable children, by meeting their spiritual, physical, educational, emotional and social needs to help children overcome their life circumstances and break free from the cycle of generational poverty. - Passport & Visa Information Each person needs a US passport, and it must be valid at least SIX MONTHS beyond stay in country.
- Immunizations Make sure you are up to date on routine vaccines (MMR, Tetanus, etc.)
- Weather In October, Mazatlan is relatively dry. The average high temperature is in the mid to upper 80's and the low temperature is in the upper 50's to lower 60's.
- Accommodations While in Mazatlan the team will be staying at a gated Back2Back Campus.
- Ground Transportation The team will fly into Mazatlan, Mexico and will be traveling by chartered bus to all locations in country, driven by Back2Back staff.
- Medical attention In the event of a serious illness or medical emergency, there are medical clinics and hospitals nearby. Included in your trip cost is travel medical insurance that will cover expenses if medical attention is needed while outside of the US.
