- Missional Partner/Organization Nicaragua Resource Network (NRN): NRN works towards restoring the dignity and potential that often lay hidden in the lives of those living on the margins of society. They accomplish this through a variety of ministries that focus on empowerment through education, health care, leadership training, and special needs ministries.
- Passport & Visa Information Each person needs a US passport, and it must be valid at least SIX MONTHS beyond stay in country.
- Immunizations Make sure you are up to date on routine vaccines (MMR, Tetanus, etc.). Hepatitis A and Typhoid are recommended.
- Weather There is an average of 9 days of rain during the month of July. The average high temperatures are in the low 90's and the average low temperatures are in the mid 70's.
- Accommodations While in Nicaragua the team will be staying in a local hotel.
- **Ground Transportation** The team will fly into Managua and is then transported to the various areas they will serve during the week by bus or van.
- Medical attention In the event of a serious illness or medical emergency, there are
 medical clinics and hospitals nearby. Included in your trip cost is travel medical
 insurance that will cover expenses if medical attention is needed while outside of the
 US.
