**Trip Information: Focus on Sports camp for HS students in Slovakia (must be at least a junior or senior in HS to participate)**

- **Missional Partner/Organization – Josiah Venture (JV):** We are excited to partner with Josiah Venture as it ignites a movement of God within the hearts of central and eastern European youth, where Christianity has nearly been extinguished. JV is having tremendous influence engaging youth through English, music, and sports camps. As a result of these camps, youth are coming to Christ in unprecedented numbers as they learn about the love of Jesus and how they can use their talents for His glory.
- **Passport & Visa Information** – Each person needs a US passport, and it must be valid at least SIX MONTHS beyond stay in country.
- **Immunizations** – Make sure you are up to date on routine vaccines (MMR, Tetanus, etc.). Hepatitis A is recommended.
- **Weather** – There are on average around 8-9 days of rain in late June / early July. The average high temperature is in the mid 70's, and the average low temperature is in the mid to upper 50's.
- **Accommodations** – While in Slovakia the team will be staying in dorms at the campsite.
- **Ground Transportation** – The team will fly into Vienna, Austria and then take a bus to Bratislava, Slovakia. From there they will be picked up by JV staff and taken to the campsite at Tisovec.
- **Medical attention** – In the event of a serious illness or medical emergency, there are medical clinics and hospitals nearby. Included in your trip cost is travel medical insurance that will cover expenses if medical attention is needed while outside of the US.
